

Information that might help answer some of your questions:

STATE IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS FOR MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENTS- All students age 11 or over are required to have the Tdap vaccine. I am required to review the immunization record to check for compliance . A copy of the current immunization record is required. You can check the State requirements at

MILFORD SCHOOL DISTRICT REQUIREMENTS:

PHYSICAL EXAMS -All students new to the Milford School District are required to have a physical exam dated within 1 year of the child's first day at school. Examples: if the first day of school is August 31, 2017 then the physical exam must be dated August 31, 2016. If the first day your child attends school is February 1, 2018 then the exam must be dated February 1, 2017.

SPORTS EXAMS- Sports exams must be dated June 1, 2017 or after and that will be valid until your child attends high school. If the sports exam was done before June 1st then your child will need another sports exam 1 year from previous sports exam.

MEDICATIONS AT SCHOOL

Medications at School –

Please complete a **Parent/Physician for Medication** form for any prescription and over the counter medications that may be needed in school (Epi-Pens, inhalers , ADHD medications, etc). The form needs to be dated June 1, 2017 or after. ***All prescription medications must be supplied in the original pharmacy container. The parent or Guardian must bring the medication to the Nurse's Office.***

Students are allowed to carry their own Epi-Pens or inhaler with the parent and doctor's agreement that your child is responsible to do so.

I do carry Tums, Tylenol (chewable and regular tablets), Ibuprofen (tablets only), and Benadryl (not Dye-free) for allergic reactions. If your child has an Epi-Pen or epinephrine pen then please also provide the Benadryl fast dissolving tablets. They are quicker to take effect. I also carry throat lozenges and cough drops.

If your child needs to take a temporary prescription medication at school (example – an antibiotic or eye drops) then we require the Parent/ MD Permission form to be completed. Medications that are ordered for 1 to 3 times a day are to be given at home.
