The following items are required for your classes:

TEAM FREEDOM:

- 1 – One subject spiral notebook (Social Studies)
- 1 – Three-subject spiral notebook (English)
- 2 – One inch binders (Math & Science)
- 1 – Three inch binder (shared for Eng & SS)
- 15 - Subject Dividers for a binder
- 1 roll clear tape (English)
- A calculator (no cell phone or ipods will be allowed)
- 1 package college ruled loose leaf paper for binder (Math & Sci)
- 2 – Expo dry erase markers
- 1 – Metric/English Ruler
- 1 – Water bottle
- Pens & Pencils

Please Note: Binders should be different colors for each class

TEAM LIBERTY:

- 4 - 1” three ring binders, different color for *each* class (English, Science, Math, Social Studies)
- 15 section dividers for binders (to be divided between Science, Social Studies, English, Math)
- 3 – two pocket folders (for English, Science and Social Studies)
- 1 single subject spiral notebook (English)
- red pens
- ruler with Metric and English measurements (Science & Math)
- loose leaf paper or single subject notebook (Math)
- Expo dry erase markers (Math)
- A calculator (scientific is preferred (no cell phone or ipods will be allowed))

Additional items required for both teams:

- Pencils and blue/black pens (mechanical pencils need replacement lead)
- Colored pencils
- Package of Small post-it type notes
- Highlighter
- Zippered pencil pouch
- **World Language** – 1 folder & 1 subject notebook
- **BAND students** - Standard of Excellence Method Book 2 for your instrument
- 1 – 1” Binder
- **Chorus students** – 1 – 1” binder any color
- 1 folder
