

Attendance

Since we are approximately halfway through the school year, I would like to review our attendance and tardy procedures. While we are aware that there have been a lot of illnesses this winter, it is important that parents call the absent line when a student is sick. If a student is sick for several days, we would appreciate any medical information that supports the reason for the absences. If there are other reasons for your child's absence, please let us know. Our school counselors are also available to provide any emotional support your child might need.

In addition to regular school attendance, it is also important that students arrive to school on time. Students arriving at school after 7:35 must report to the main office, and should have an excuse note signed by a parent or guardian. Unexcused tardies will result in an office detention following three unexcused tardies per marking period. Tardiness exceeding the three days may result in detentions and/or suspensions.
