Dear Parent/Guardian:

All students in the middle school receive Unified Arts classes throughout the school year which include Consumer Ed., Technology Ed., Art, Music, P.E., and Health. As students begin to develop their interests in those areas, Milford Middle School offers electives for 7th and 8th grade students to help foster that interest.

For the 2019-2020 school year, in addition to the Unified Arts all students get in their schedules, students will be given the opportunity to sign up for either Band, Chorus, or Art Exploration in place of Study Halls and Music. A description of each is offered below. These are yearlong classes that will occur every other day. (Students currently enrolled in Band and Chorus will automatically be scheduled into that class for next year unless they choose to drop that elective.)

Band and Chorus

The objectives in Band and Chorus involve singing and playing instruments; reading and notating music; listening to, analyzing, and describing music; evaluating music and musical performances; composing and arranging music; and understanding the relationships between music, the other arts, and disciplines outside of the arts. A musical ensemble is more than just playing an instrument or singing. It is immersing your child in a culture of successful students and teachers who care about education. It challenges each child to use the creative side of their brain while, at the same time, learning a new language...MUSIC.

**If your child is new to an instrument, private instruction is strongly recommended to catch your child up with the band. Please contact Mrs. Lowy for more information at 673-5221*

The Science of Art Exploration

Students will have the opportunity to pursue and experiment with a variety of art materials and techniques. Over the duration of the course students will be encouraged to use critical thinking and problem solving skills through exploration and experimentation using various art mediums. Throughout this course, students will be diving into content areas such as recycled arts, community based arts, photography, art history, and so much more. In this course, students will also be able to choose subject areas or materials that they have yet to use in previous art classes.

**This class will be offered in addition to the art classes students currently receive.*
