



2019 Student Lunar Art Contest: The Moon To Me

Contest Guidelines and Conditions:

- The entry must be an original work by the contestant that focuses on the moon.
- Artwork may use watercolors, acrylics, oils, crayons, pencils, mixed media, ceramics, etc., but **may not be photography. No edible materials may be used.**
- 2-D artwork must be presented horizontally on paper or other non-edible material.
- 2-D artwork must be no larger than 11" height x 14" width.
- 3-D artwork must be constructed to withstand **repeated handling by staff** during entry, judging and display. Ceramics must be fired. Mobiles, stained glass, masks and other hanging 3-D exhibits must be equipped with secure hanging point(s) or screw eye(s). Size limit for 3-D entries is 18" height X 18" width X 12" depth.
- Participant's name is to be written on the back/bottom of the entry, **not** on the front/top/side.
- Entry should **not** be framed, matted, or delivered in a display case.
- All work must be self-produced and cannot be computer generated and/or computer enhanced.
- Artwork that has been submitted to other competitions is not eligible for this contest.
- Winning (awarded) entries are not eligible for other contests.
- Only one entry per participant will be accepted; additional art entries will be disqualified.
- Completed official entry form and release must accompany entry. Child and parent or guardian's signature is required on entry form.
- All mailed 2-D entries should be post-marked no later than Friday, June 28, 2019.
- All hand-delivered entries must be received by Tuesday, July 2, 2019.
- Entries that do not comply with all of the contest rules will be disqualified.
- Un-awarded artwork for this contest may be returned if a correctly-sized self-addressed envelope with proper postage is included with 2-D entries; artwork can also be picked up at McAuliffe-Shepard Discovery Center after making arrangements with Mirka Zapletal. Artwork will be available for return starting September 1, 2019.

Categories:

- Group 1: Ages 5-7 Group 2: Ages 8-10 Group 3: Ages 11-13 Group 4: Ages 14-18

Prizes:

*First place winners in all categories will receive a family membership to McAuliffe-Shepard Discovery Center for one year.

*Second place winners will receive a 2-person membership to McAuliffe-Shepard Discovery Center for one year.

*Third place winners will receive a family day pass, planetarium show included, to McAuliffe-Shepard Discovery Center.

All winners will be notified by email no later than Friday, July 12, 2019.
